

Million Fishes Art Collective is once again offering the Embark Grant, this time to Bay Area performance artists. Intended to support artists in our communities by funding and providing resources for new work, the grant consists of 25 hours of rehearsal time, a \$200 artist fee, and the opportunity to present the work developed.

**The submission deadline is February 20th, 2012.**

The Spring 2012 Embark Grant is open to Bay Area artists with a performance component to their work such as movement-based performance, theater, or butoh. Cross-disciplinary and new-media projects are encouraged. Note that the rehearsal space does not have traditional dance flooring. Performances that are primarily musical will not be considered.
